Students in Ms. Peterson's first grade class enjoy listening to a book called, *Please Say Please*.



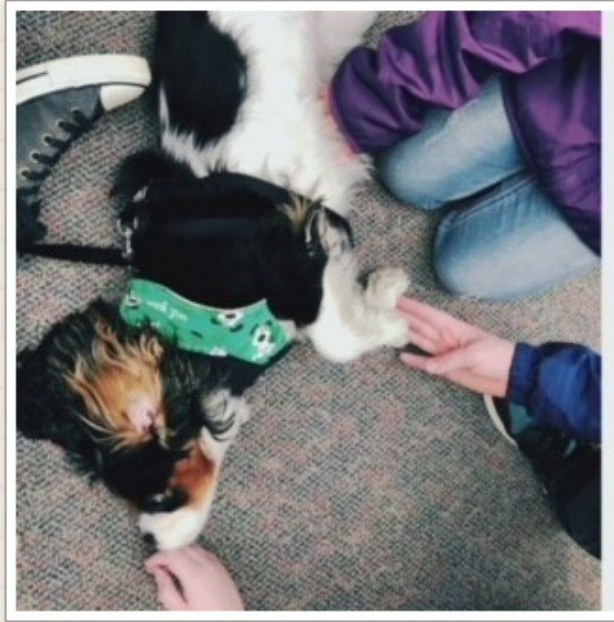
2ND GRADE
