

## **GRADING AND PROGRESS REPORTS SPRING 2020 ONLY**

### **Grading and Progress Reports from April 22, 2020 through June 18, 2020**

Due to the National and State Coronavirus Pandemic, Omak School District will implement the following grading rules for the final grading period of the 2019-20 school year at North Omak Elementary, East Omak Elementary, Omak Middle School, Omak High School, and Highlands High School.

#### **Students in Grades Kindergarten - 5**

Students in grades K–5 will be challenged to demonstrate effort and success in learning standards established by their teachers. All students will move on to the next grade, unless by mutual agreement between parents/guardians and teachers they agree to repeat a grade or a portion of learning missed.

#### **Students in Grades 6 – 8**

Students in grades 6-8 will be challenged to demonstrate effort and success in learning standards established by their teachers. All students will move on to the next grade, unless by mutual agreement between parents/guardians and teachers they agree to repeat a grade or a portion of learning missed.

#### **Students in Grades 9 - 12**

- a. All students in grades 9-12 will be graded off the following standards (this includes any 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade students taking courses for high school credit):

Incomplete	Passing Grade (A, B, C, D)
The student did not engage.	The student engaged in learning to the extent possible given their situation.

- b. No student will receive a “pass,” “fail,” or “no credit” grade for any course.
- c. Students are encouraged to remain engaged in learning through the closure period so that no Incomplete grade is given. **Incomplete grades are required to be made up by state law.**
- d. Every class taken during the closure period will be given a statewide designator on the high school transcript to demote the unique environment in which the course was taken.
- e. All students will be given an opportunity to engage in remote and continuous learning to maintain or improve their mastery of essential standards in preparation for future school and work.
- f. All course work for credit must be submitted by June 3<sup>rd</sup> for 12<sup>th</sup> graders and June 11<sup>th</sup> for all other grades.
